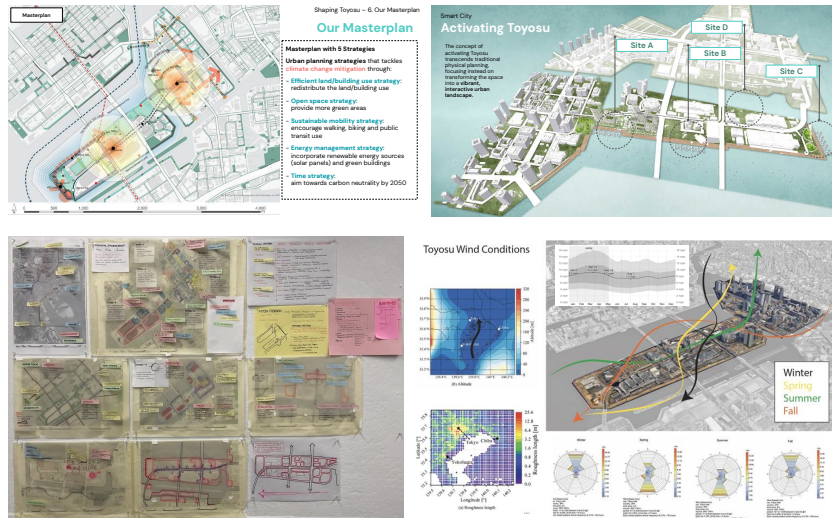


Public Presentation Event
